

<p><u>Positive diagnosis (YES)</u></p> <p>“In regard to the patient's history of atrial fibrillation, she reports that she had occasional short episodes of a rapid rate that lasts a minute”</p> <p>“He has severe tricuspid regurgitation due to a partial flail tricuspid leaflet and a history of anemia.”</p>	<p><u>Negative diagnosis (NO)</u></p> <p>“She has no history of chronic lung disease, rheumatic fever, or endocarditis.”</p> <p>“Although her right ventricle is compromised she is quite well compensated hemodynamically without evidence of right ventricular failure.”</p>
<p><u>Suspected Diagnosis (MAYBE)</u></p> <p>“However, this could also be due to interstitial lung diseases such as sarcoidosis, hypersensitivity pneumonitis, or Langerhans cell histiocytosis.”</p> <p>“Because of the swelling I wonder about the possibility of cor pulmonale and underlying pulmonary hypertension.”</p>	<p><u>Alternate Context (OTHER)</u></p> <p>“I have also sent him a copy of our recent paper on smoking-related interstitial lung diseases.”</p> <p>“She has no family history of lung fibrosis or other lung diseases.”</p>
